### **Adoption Statement**

In accordance with Regulation 19 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulation 2004, notice is given that South Lakeland District Council formally adopted the Cumbria Wind Energy Supplementary Planning Document on 5<sup>th</sup> December 2007.

The Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) sets out the Council's guidance on assessing proposals for wind energy developments in the area of South Lakeland outside the Lake District and Yorkshire Dales National Parks. The SPD supplements the policies in the South Lakeland Local Plan and Alteration relating to Wind Energy.
