**The Diary of a Kendal Midwife** (2002) £9.00/£10.50\*\* Of tremendous value to family historians as it covers a period (1669-1675) when the parish records are missing. It names the child, the father, area/house of the family.

**'The Rake's Diary'. The Journal of George Hilton** (1994) £7.49 / £9.49\*\* Intriguing picture of life in Westmorland, 1673-1724, recorded by a gentleman of scandalous reputation.

**John Burns' Diary** (1999) £5.50 / £6.50\*\* Enthralling account of 1250 mile walk to imprisonment in the Loire Valley and back to England by a Whitehaven mariner, captured by the French in 1799.

**The Diary of John Bragg from Whitehaven** edited by Jean Ward (1999) £5.50/£6.50\*\* A Quaker shoemaker's fascinating account of 18th century life. Contains references to family events, everyday life in Whitehaven, and developments abroad.

**Skelton, Penrith and the World 1943-1993: Half a Century of a Cumbrian Village helping a Nation to speak to a Nation** by Ken Davies (1995) £4.49/£5.99\*\* Stories about the BBC Transmitting Station and its impact on the local community.

**The English Lakes. Tales from History, Legend and Folklore** by David Ramshaw (1996) £4.49/£5.99\*\* Stories derived from a wide range of sources, ranging from the early guide writers in the Lake District to interviews with present day inhabitants.

**The Man Wants His Boat: Stories of Barrow Shipyard** by Alan Lockett (1995) £9.95/£10.95\*\* The shipyard at Barrow has been producing ships and submarines since 1871. This book tells stories of people who were involved in the building of these ships during the 44 years of the author's time there.

**The Dons Delivered: Ships Built at Vickers 1930-1947** by Alec Dancer (1996) £6.00/£7.00\*\* A vibrant illustration of the work and play of the shipbuilders of this era.
