Support for Reading Groups in Schools

Chatterpacks is a new service offered by Library Services for Schools to support both new and existing reading groups. The Reading Agency started *Chatterbooks Reading Groups* in public libraries over 8 years ago. This is now being expanded into schools in Cumbria as *Chatterpacks*.

Chatterpacks will

- 📖 make reading fun and promote reading for pleasure
- 📖 encourage pupils to read more widely
- 📖 give confidence in talking and writing about books and reading
- 📖 support schools in reaching targets in key agendas ie SEAL & Creativity
- 📖 provide an opportunity for professional development for school staff



The new service is available through subscription and comprises:

- 📖 6 exciting themes – choose from mission impossible; funny; animals; unreal; spooky; dragons
- 📖 a variety of books at KS2 level including: fiction; non fiction; poetry; myths and legends; activity books. 20 books per box.
- 📖 On line activities – your own personal password giving you access to book related activities on Moodle
