



If you live within the rural areas of Allerdale, and outside the town boundaries of Workington and Maryport, as shown on the map on the reverse of this page, then you are eligible to join Rural Wheels.

You may use the service if you do not have access to public transport.

Rural Wheels can be used to link you up with the bus or train, or take you to your nearest town to access shops, attend appointments etc.

When you need to purchase more points for your Rural Wheels card, you can purchase in amounts of £5, £10 or £15 at a time from your Rural Wheels Transport Operator.
