### Glenridding

The village of Glenridding, situated at the southern end of the lake, is popular with tourists of all kinds but especially mountain walkers who can scale England's third highest mountain, Helvellyn, and many other challenging peaks from there.

### Sail Away on Ullswater

Ullswater is the second largest lake in the Lake District at 8 miles long. Ullswater Steamers have been sailing on the lake for over 150 years and have piers at Glenridding, Pooley Bridge and Howtown. They currently have four vessels operating lake cruises; Lady of the Lake originally launched in 1877 (she is believed to be the oldest working passenger vessel in the world), Raven in 1889, Lady Dorothy in 2001 and Lady Wakefield in 2007.

The world associates Donald Campbell and Bluebird with Coniston, so many visitors to Glenridding are surprised to see the Campbell commemoration stone at the Ullswater lakeside. However, Donald Campbell set the world water speed record on Ullswater on July 23rd 1955, when he piloted the jet-propelled hydroplane 'Bluebird K7' to a speed of 202.32 mph.

### Aira Force - probably the most famous of the Lake District waterfalls

Situated on land owned by the National Trust, the main force falls 70 feet from below a stone footbridge; providing a glimpse of a landscaped Victorian park with dramatic waterfalls, arboretum and rocks scenery.

A cafe near the Aira Force bus stop, contains information describing the area. Wheelchair and pram access to Aira Beck is possible.



### Pooley Bridge

Straddling the River Eamont at the head of Ullswater, Pooley Bridge is graced by its 16th century bridge. Two wide main streets lined with greystone houses, teashops, and tourist services look over the lake.
